Paskal Milo, born on 22 February 1949, is an Albanian historian and politician. He graduated from Tirana University in 1970. He has been a member of the Albanian Parliament since 1992, and has held various posts under the Albanian Government in the late 1990s and early 2000s, including that of the Foreign Minister from 1997-2001, as well as that of the Minister of European Integration of Albania (2001-2002)

During his tenure as Foreign Minister, he advocated the Euro-Atlantic integration of Albania, as well as the regional cooperation within the Western Balkans framework.

As a Foreign Minister he was closely involved in finding a solution to the Kosovo crisis working together with several European and American dignitaries. Currently he is serving as a Professor of Albanian Foreign Policy History and European Integration History at the Tirana University.

He has authored relevant books for the History of Albania, including: Albanian-German crossroads (2016), Albanians in the Second World War (First volume-2014), Foreign Policy of Albania 1912-1939 (First Volume-2013), Hidden Truths. The Corfu Channel Incident (2010), Diary of a Foreign Minister. Kosovo Conflict (2009), European Union, Ideas, Integration, Identity, Future (2002), etc.
