



Ambassador Bekim Sejdiu

Ambassador Bekim Sejdiu was born on 23 October 1974. Currently he serves as a judge of the Constitutional Court of the Republic of Kosovo (2015 – 2014), as well as lecturer at the Faculty of Law of the University of Prishtina. He belongs to the first generation of ambassadors of the Republic of Kosovo.

Ambassador Sejdiu has served as Ambassador of the Republic of Kosovo to the Republic of Turkey (2008 – 2012) and Consul General of the Republic of Kosovo in New York (2012-2014). Before being assigned as Ambassador, he served as a political advisor in the Cabinet of the First Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Kosovo.

Ambassador Sejdiu has completed his law studies at the Law Faculty of the University of Prishtina. He has completed two master studies programs, namely the master degree program in the area of international relations at the University of Bilkent, Ankara and master degree program in the area of democracy and human rights at the University of Sarajevo and University of Bologna. Ambassador Sejdiu has earned his doctoral degree in International and Diplomatic Studies, at the Faculty of Government and European Studies – Nova Univerza, Kranj, Slovenia.

Prior to joining the diplomatic service and in addition working at the University of Prishtina, Ambassador Sejdiu was active part of the civil society in Kosovo, thus being part of the founding group of Kosovo Institute for Policy Research and Development – KIPRED, as well as program director at the Kosovo Foundation for Civil Society – KFCS.

During his public activity, Ambassador Sejdiu has being awarded with a number of decorations and medals, including the decoration of the Assembly of New York State (USA), Key of the City of Worcester (Massachusetts, USA) and a medal from the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Turkey.

Having being an active part in the university teaching, Ambassador Sejdiu has conducted study visits to different universities in Europe and USA. He has published numerous academic articles and scientific works, some of which were published in prestigious international academic journals.

Ambassador Sejdiu is married to Alberie Sejdiu (Rraci), a teacher at the primary school “Hasan Prishtina” in Prishtina. They have three children: Melisa, Samira and Jon.
