

Anton Berisha was born on 20th October 1966. He is married with Helena Berisha and has four children.

He has been involved in social, political and cultural events since his student days, including the national movement of the 90s, handling specific diplomatic missions authorized by president Ibrahim Rugova.

Mr. Berisha belongs to the first generation of career ambassadors appointed in 2009.

He has served as the first ambassador of Kosovo in Slovenia.
