

Klajda Gjosha was born in Tirana, on 28 July 1983. She is married with two children. Mrs. Gjosha attained a Master's degree in European Studies in 2006 and graduated with BA Hons in Politics and International Relations (2005) in the University of Reading, United Kingdom. She has served as Member of the Parliament and also as Deputy Chair of the Foreign Affairs Committee (2017-2019), as Minister of European Integration in the Government of Albania (2013-2017) and Deputy Minister of Labor, Social Affairs and Equal Opportunities (2012-2013).
